Period: January to June 2023

In Africa, people with disabilities and vulnerable elderly people continue to face difficulties in accessing assistive care and technical aids.

Since 2011, OADCPH has been committed to promoting access to assistive technologies and rehabilitation care for a greater number of people in Africa. To achieve this, it is currently working in 5 areas:

- The supply of assistive products via its central purchasing unit,
- Training for rehabilitation professionals, service managers and administrative staff,
- The development of innovative solutions to improve the supply of rehabilitation services in Africa,
- Advisory support for service development and technical issues, and
- Helping the most vulnerable to access services.
 In this area, OADCPH supports vulnerable disabled and elderly people, providing them with the equipment they need for their care, and facilitating their treatment in member rehabilitation centers.

During the first half of 2023, we collaborated with our partners to meet the needs of vulnerable disabled and elderly people across Africa.

Together, we are working to open up prospects towards independence, offering disabled and elderly people opportunities equal to those of others, with the aim of building a more inclusive society.



Some beneficiaries


